From 26 September to 18 October 2017. (upto 11.50 PM)

Candidates can print Admit Card from 23 October 2017 after 6.00 PM to 10 November 2017 8.00 AM using his/her application number & password.

Submission of Application (through online) :

After Payment of application fee, candidate must fill the Application Form available at www.bsmmu.edu.bd within above mentioned deadline.

Candidate has to upload scanned copy of her/his '**color photograph**' (not older than six months), '**Bank payment receipt**' and '**Signature**'. Please keep a small file size of your color photograph that can be uploaded easily.

Eligibility criteria & information for candidates intending to apply for MD/MS Phase-A Residency Program to be started on 01 March'2018

1. All Government/Autonomous candidates should know Deputation rules/study leave rules of their employer.
2. Govt. Candidates will not be selected in Private Medical Colleges/Institutes.
3. Candidates must have:
 - i. MBBS/BDS or equivalent degree (recognized by BMDC)
 - ii. One Year Internship training certificate
 - iii. Completed one year after Internship on or before 28 February 2018
 - iv. BMDC Permanent registration certificate valid on or after 31 August'2018
4. Govt. candidates must have at least 2 (two) years of service for all courses except in the following cases:
 - i. Applicants intend to apply for the following courses do not require any work experience at any level:
 - a. All disciplines under Faculty of Basic Science and Para Clinical Science.
 - b. MD Residency Program in Anesthesiology and MS Residency Program in Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery under Faculty of Surgery.
 - ii. Candidates with one year work experience in remote area (as per Govt. Deputation Rules) can apply for any discipline.
5. BSMMU candidates must have at least 2 (two) years of regular service in BSMMU for all courses except in the following cases:

Applicants intend to apply for the following courses do not require any work experience at any level:

 - a. All disciplines under Faculty of Basic Science and Para Clinical Science.
 - b. MD Residency Program in Anesthesiology and MS Residency Program in Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery under Faculty of Surgery.
6. Maximum 45-year age as on 28 February 2018 (candidate with Date of Birth 01 March'1973 or after can apply).
7. Govt./BSMMU candidates must have 03 (three) years active service in the respective field after obtaining any postgraduate degree.
8. Student already in a course can not apply. The student will become eligible to apply for any course 01 (one) year after withdrawal from the course.

The above mentioned rule (i.e., obligation of one year after withdrawal) is not applicable for the applicants applying in any MD/MS courses offered by the Faculty of Basic Science & Para clinical Science and MD in Anesthesiology.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) for MD/MS Phase-A Residency Program March-2018

1. Question:

Which documents a candidate should have during submission of her/his application?

Answer:

Following documents are required to provide correct information,

- Permanent and updated BMDC Registration (valid on or after 31 August 2018).
- National Identification Card (NID).
- Internship Certificate.
- Job Related Documents.

2. Question:

Which items a Candidate have to scan and upload along with the application?

Answer:

A Candidate should scan images of

- Her/his passport size color Photograph
- Signature and
- Bank Deposit Receipt

3. Question:

Which information from Bank Deposit Receipt is to be mentioned?

Answer:

- Bank Scroll number
- Serial number
- Date of Money deposit
- Name of the Branch

4. Question:

When a candidate can get her/his Admit Card?

Answer:

Candidates can print Admit Card from 23 October 2017 after 6.00 PM to 10 November 2017 8.00 AM using his/her password & application number.

5. Question:

Is there any age limit for applying?

Answer:

Yes, 45-year age as on 28 February 2018

6. Question:

Is completion of internship mandatory?

Answer:

Yes, must complete one year internship.

7. Question:

Is any period is necessary after internship?

Answer:

Yes, one year after completion of internship on or before 28 February 2018, is mandatory

8. Question:

Is provisional registration number of BMDC is acceptable?

Answer:

No, candidate must have permanent registration number of BMDC, validity on or after 31 August 2018.

9. Question:

How many years, a government candidate, need to serve before applying for admission into Post-graduate course?

Answer:

At least 2 (two) years of service for all courses except in the following cases:

- i. Applicants intend to apply for the following courses do not require any work experience at any level:
 - a. All disciplines under Faculty of Basic Science and Para Clinical Science.
 - b. MD Residency Program in Anesthesiology and MS Residency Program in Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery under Faculty of Surgery.
- ii. Candidates with one year work experience in remote area (as per Govt. Deputation Rules) can apply for any discipline.

10. Question:

How many years, a BSMMU candidate, need to serve before applying for admission into Post-graduate course?

Answer:

At least 2 (two) years of regular service in BSMMU for all courses except in the following cases:

Applicants intend to apply for the following courses do not require any work experience at any level:

- a. All disciplines under Faculty of Basic Science and Para Clinical Science.
- b. MD Residency Program in Anesthesiology and MS Residency Program in Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery under Faculty of Surgery.

11. Question:

How many years of government service are required after last deputation?

Answer:

Candidate must know the Govt. Deputation Rules.

12. Question:

Did you leave course willingly/course out/cancellation of deputation?

Answer:

Candidate must know the Govt. Deputation Rules.

13. Question:

Can a candidate choose more than one discipline?

Answer:

No, candidate has to choose one discipline only.

14. Question:

Can a candidate choose more than one institute?

Answer:

Yes, candidate can choose maximum of three institutes (if options of institutes are available for that particular discipline).

15. Question:

How many years required for a Govt./BSMMU candidate to give service in respective specialty after obtaining any postgraduate degree?

Answer:

Govt./BSMMU candidates must have three years active service in the respective field after obtaining any postgraduate degree.

16. Question:

Can the information provided in the application form be modified?

Answer:

Candidate can modify their application as long as she/he not pressed the 'Final Submit' button. Once the 'Final Submit' button has been pressed, candidate is no longer allowed to modify.
